The City of Delano received grant funding from the Live Wright Grant Program, a program of Wright County Human Services, designated for the overall Park and Trails master plan along with park and trail signage. This grant gave the City of Delano an opportunity to update its Parks and Trails Master Plan, focusing on the natural and historical characteristics of our community, existing parks and trail facilities, engaging residents and organizations for projected recreational needs in order to meet existing and future needs in an efficient and effective manner.

City Staff and the Parks and Recreation Committee worked closely together in order to create the Delano Parks and Trails Kiosks available throughout the community; the kiosks were installed to raise awareness and allow trail users with live mapping to enhance their recreational experience.

Additionally, the Live Wright Grant Program allowed City Staff to enhance the mapping systems available on the City's website; allowing residents the ability to interact and gain knowledge of the existing trail and park opportunities within the Delano Community, as well as the Delano School District various playing fields.
