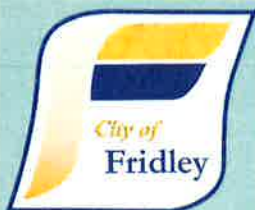


Get the Buckthorn Out!

Buckthorn is an invasive species of tree that has become widespread throughout Innsbruck Park. If left alone, the buckthorn will continue to spread and kill native plants and trees.
