RESOLUTION SETTING NEW UTILITY RATES

WHEREAS, the City of Winthrop has water and sewer utilities; and

WHEREAS, City staff and the City Council have research and studied current utility rates and have determined that it is necessary for the fiscal and structural health of the utility and City to increase said utility rates.

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota is requiring that municipal water utilities adopt a conservation schedule regarding utility usage and rates

WHEREAS, the proposed new utility rates are as follows:

RESIDENTIAL WATER:

<u>Usage (in gallons per month)</u>	<u>Rate</u>
0 to 10,000	\$10 base \$2.27 per 1,000 gallons
10,001 to 20,000	\$3.27 per 1,000 gallons
20,001 and up	\$4.27 per 1,000 gallons

COMMERCIAL WATER:

<u>Usage (in gallons per month)</u>	<u>Rate</u>
0 to 500,000	\$10 base \$2.13 per 1,000 gallons
500,001 to 1,000,000	\$3.13 per 1,000 gallons
1,000,001 and up	\$4.13 per 1,000 gallons

INDUSTRIAL WATER:

<u>Usage (in gallons per month)</u>	<u>Rate</u>
0 to 10,000	\$10 base \$2.13 per 1,000 gallons

\$3.13 per 1,000 gallons

20,001 and up

\$4.13 per 1,000 gallons

SEWER

\$10.50 base rate

\$3.51 per 1,000 gallons
