APPROVING THE UPDATED COGENERATION AND SMALL POWER PRODUCTION
TARIFF FOR THE TWO HARBORS ELECTRICAL DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Rules Governing Cogeneration and Small Power Production Facilities with the City of Two Harbors Electric Department and Minnesota Statutes Section 216B.164 require the utility to file a Cogeneration and Small Power Production Tariff with the Two Harbors City Council annually.

WHEREAS, Schedule 1 of this tariff provides the calculation of average retail utility energy rates.

WHEREAS, Schedule 2 provides standard contracts to be used with qualifying facilities.


WHEREAS, Schedule 3 provides the utility's safety standards, required operating procedures for interconnected operations, and the functions to be performed by any control and protective apparatus.

WHEREAS, Schedule 4 provides the rates at which the utility purchases energy and capacity from the wholesale supplier from which purchases may first be avoided.

RESOLUTION

A resolution adopting Two Harbors Electric Department's Policy Regarding Distributed Energy Resources and Net Metering and Rules Governing the Interconnection of Cogeneration and Small Power Production Facilities.

WHEREAS, the City is served by Two Harbors Electric Department, which is committed to providing customers with reliable and affordable power.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Distributed Energy Resources and Net Metering Policy is to establish the qualification criteria and certain responsibilities for the delivery, interconnection, metering, and purchase of electricity from distributed generation facilities.

WHEREAS, this policy, in accordance with Minnesota Statutes §216B.164, shall be implemented to give the maximum possible encouragement to cogeneration and small power production consistent with protection of the utility's ratepayers and the public.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Cogeneration and Small Power Production Rules is for the Two Harbors City Council to implement certain provisions of Minnesota Statutes §216B.164, the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978, and Federal Energy Regulatory Commission regulations related to customer-owned distributed energy resources.

WHEREAS, the adoption of these rules establishes that the Two Harbors City Council is the interpreting body and arbiter of the provisions of Minnesota Statutes §216B.164 for Two Harbors Electric Department.

WHEREAS, Two Harbors Electric Department shall annually file a cogeneration and small power production tariff with the Two Harbors City Council under these rules.

WHEREAS, the cogeneration and small power production tariff shall include a calculation of average retail utility energy rates, standard contracts to be used with qualifying facilities, safety standards, operating procedures, and functions to be performed by control and protective apparatus, and the wholesale rates paid for energy and capacity by Two Harbors Electric Department.

WHEREAS, all filings under these rules shall be maintained at the Two Harbors Electric Department offices and shall be made available for public inspection during normal business hours.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Two Harbors City Council adopts the following Policy Regarding Distributed Energy Resources and Net Metering and Rules Governing the Interconnection of Cogeneration and Small Power Production Facilities.
