Phase III of the Stay Safe MN plan begins today. Restaurants and gyms will begin opening their interiors to restricted capacities, salons and barbershops will increase occupancy to 50%, small indoor events will begin.

As many of us begin dining out and getting our hair done, please keep purchases in West St. Paul whenever possible. Our business owners and employees have sacrificed so much for our safety over the last few months and now it's time for those of us that are in a position to do so to pay them back.
