

















WHERE DO WE BEGIN?

This Parks, Trails, and Open Space Plan will be a decision-making guide for improvements over the next 20 years. It serves as a framework and a vision to promote the natural assets in Faribault and provide an inclusive parks and recreation system that is sustainably built, maintained, and utilized. The success of this plan requires the collaboration of everyone in the community, including the City Council, the Park and Recreation Advisory Board, City staff, regional partners, local non-profits and the public.

UPDATED PARK MASTER PLANS

Updated park master plans were generated based on the goals, policies, and action items outlined in the previous section of this master plan. They are a guiding vision and framework for improvements. Plans are organized by park classification and available in Appendix.

IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE

Making this vision a reality will not happen all at once. This master plan recognizes that the success of each action item is dependent on a variety of factors including cost, community priority, and opportunity. The following represents a timeline for proposed improvements that have been deemed high priority and/or represent a catalyst project.
