



CODE OF CONDUCT

The Code of Conduct is a list of expectations for Hermann Express customers that ensures the best possible experience for everyone.

- Ride safe, always wear a seatbelt.
- Remain seated the entire ride.
- Be at the bus stop up to 5 minutes before the scheduled pick up time. Be visible to the driver upon arrival, and be ready to board the bus.
- Must present exact fare. No Heartland Express tokens accepted.
- There is a limit of 4 bags/packages per rider.
You are responsible for your belongings, and the aisle needs to be clear at all times.
- Always be considerate of other passengers.
Inappropriate language will not be tolerated.
- No smoking on or near the bus.
- No food or beverages on the bus.
- Shoes and shirt are required.
- No firearms, weapons, fireworks, hazardous materials or chemicals are allowed on the bus.
- We reserve the right to refuse transportation to any individual at our discretion.

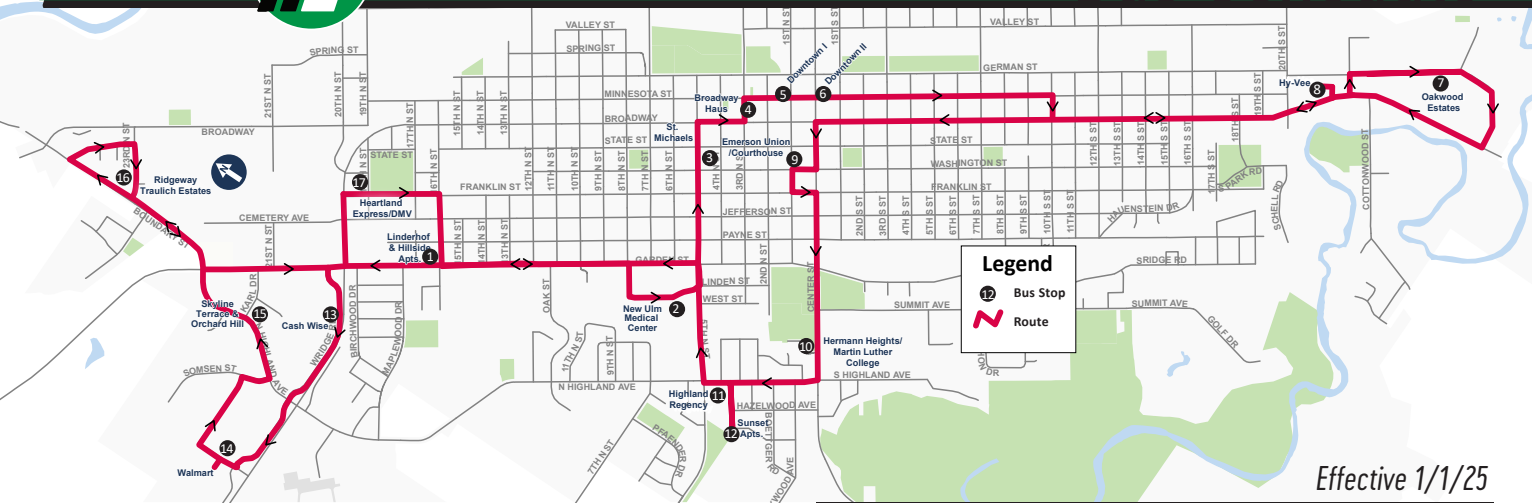

HOW TO USE THE HERMANN EXPRESS

The bus will travel a set path and stop at marked bus stops. It may go off route 1-2 blocks upon request; however, these deviations are limited to keep the bus on schedule.

The bus will serve each stop once an hour. See schedule on right. Times are approximate.

Adults and children grades K-12 are \$1.00 per ride. Children in grade pre-K and younger are \$0.50 per ride (max of 2 children per paying adult). United States Veterans ride for free (with proper identification). Exact cash is required. Drivers do not carry change. Heartland Express tokens **WILL NOT** be accepted. Fares must be paid when boarding, no exceptions.

Bus service is not available on: New Years Day, the Saturday before Easter, the Saturday before Memorial Day, Memorial Day, July 4th and 5th, the Saturday before Labor Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, the Friday and Saturday after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.

In addition to the Hermann Express service, Heartland Express, an on-demand dial-a-ride service, will continue to be available in New Ulm. See website for details.
