In order to meet the expectations of Best Practice No. 21 (Septic Systems) – Action No. 6 (Innovative waste water systems), the City of Warren has passed ordinances outlawing the implementation and usage of septic sewage systems as its homeowners and businesses exist in environmentally sensitive areas and an area where a central sewage system is the most cost efficient option. Instead, the city has focused on extending its central sewer extensions to all of its residents which have eliminated the need for septic systems. Additionally, the City of Warren utilizes its Wastewater Treatment Plant to implement recirculating ozone systems and a system to clean incoming greywater.¹
