<p>CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN</p>	<p>The City of Inver Grove Heights has developed a multi-year financing plan for its capital improvement plan ("CIP"). This document outlines "what, when, where and cost" of citywide projects. This document also incorporates cash and debt funding sources, so City leaders can determine the appropriate future fiscal impacts of the proposed capital projects.
